## ***SURVEY OF KINGWOOD AND TOMBALL ADJUNCT FACULTY NOW BEING CONDUCTED***

Beth Lewis, a doctoral candidate in Educational Leadership at Sam Houston State University, is currently conducting research involving the adjunct faculty at Kingwood and Tomball Colleges. The four-page survey was mailed to the homes of the adjunct faculty members last week, with a requested return date of April 28. However, completed surveys can be returned through May 12. The objectives of this dissertation research are to determine what institutional support adjuncts value in their position and how well they think their needs are being met. Ms. Lewis has received approval to conduct this research in NHMCCD from Dr. Pickelman, Dr. Head, and the college presidents involved, Dr. Stegall and Dr. Troyer, as well as the Human Subjects Committee at SHSU.

Because both Ms. Lewis and her husband, Nick, have been adjunct faculty members, she knows first-hand the special demands and stresses part-timers face. When she began researching the topic for her dissertation, Ms. Lewis noticed the dearth of quantitative research which solicited the opinions of the faculty members themselves instead of the opinions of administrators. She hopes this project will add to the body of quantitative literature on adjunct faculty opinions.

To insure anonymity in responses, Ms. Lewis chose not to code the addresses by college or participant. Therefore, she is not able to determine which faculty members have returned the surveys and which have not. If you are an adjunct faculty member at Kingwood College or Tomball College and have not yet returned your completed survey, we encourage you to do so as soon as possible.
