

Scholarships

AFT members and their dependents are eligible to apply for union-sponsored scholarships toward postsecondary education.

Student Debt Clinics

AFT members can learn about the landscape of free and underused federal programs that help many student loan borrowers lower their monthly payments and, in some cases, even have their debt forgiven.

Summer and Savi: Simplifying Student Debt

Summer is an online resource—free to AFT members—that helps members with federal student loans to apply for income-driven debt repayment. Savi is for members and their families and offers three options for customized student loan assistance.

Affordable College

AFT members receive exclusive discounts for college, so costs don't stand in the way of their family's education dreams.

Personal Loans

Credit-qualified AFT members can consolidate high-interest credit cards and revolving debts with a personal loan with no hidden fees and one monthly payment.

Credit Union

AFT members can join a full-service financial institution that provides checking, savings and money market accounts with no monthly fees. Members can apply for auto loans and more.

Credit and Budget Counseling

Certified nonprofit credit counselors are available 24 hours a day to help AFT members with confidential financial guidance and credit counseling services.

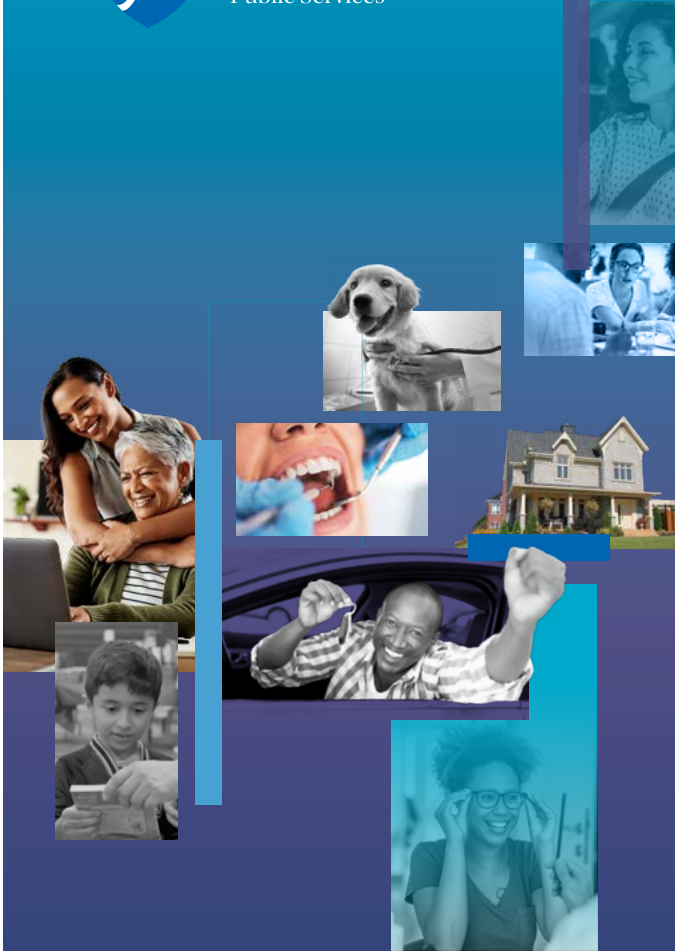
